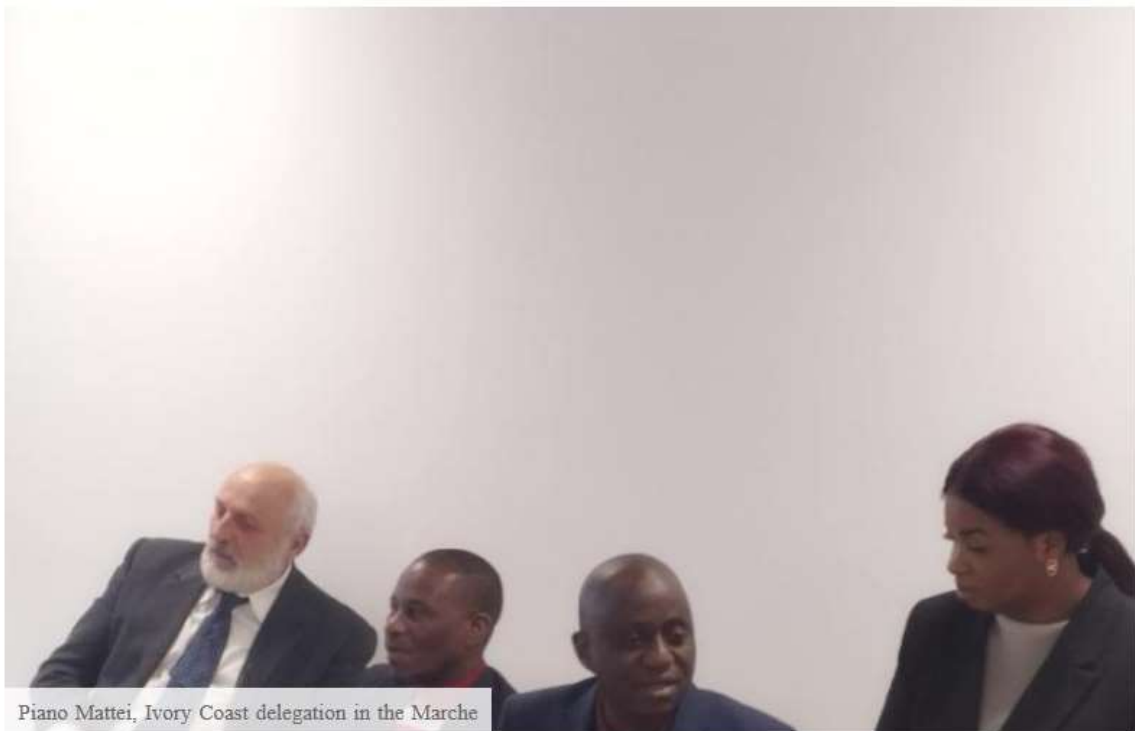

The Mattei Plan aims to strengthen the partnership between Italy and African countries through the disbursement, over the next four years, of funds for a value equal to **5.5 billion euros**aiming to stimulate further investments from both the private and institutional sectors.

The data on trade relations and investments between the two regions testify to a consolidated interaction between the two areas.

The main Italian trading partners by 2022 the countries of the North African area are confirmed, followed by South Africa, various West African nations (such as Nigeria, **Ivory Coast** and Senegal), as well as from Angola and Congo.

As of 2017, they were **1,740 Italian companies are present in Africa** with a total turnover of almost 26 billion euros, operating not only in the energy sector, but also in the construction, transport, logistics and mechanical sectors.
